Cleaning & Maintenance Manual

Shower Screens

- Shower Screen glass should be cleaned daily, or at least weekly to remove soap stains.
- For general cleaning purposes, a mild detergent or vinegar diluted in water should be administered with a clean, soft cloth.
- The cloth should be free from any grit or detergent residue.
- A plastic squeegee is useful in removing water and soap residue.
- Do not under any circumstances use any form of abrasive cleaner as this may cause damage to the glass for example Jif.
- Do not clean with steel wool, razorblades etc.
- Do not allow any metal or hard parts of other cleaning equipment to come in contact with the glass.

Toughened Mirror Splashbacks

- When cleaning/sealing DO NOT use any alcohol/ethanol-based cleaning products e.g., Methylated Spirits or Citro Clean this will affect the backing paint.
- Before cleaning wash away any build-up of fatty or greasy deposits using a soft sponge and warm soapy water. Many cleaners will only smear such deposits over the surface of the glass.
- For general cleaning purposes, a mild detergent or vinegar diluted in water should be administered with a clean, soft cloth.
- The cloth should be free from any grit or detergent residue.
- A plastic squeegee is useful in removing water residue.
- Do not under any circumstances use any form of abrasive cleaner as this may cause damage to the glass for example Jif.
- Do not clean with steel wool, razorblades etc.
- Do not allow any metal or hard parts of other cleaning equipment to come in contact with the glass.

Mirrored Robe Doors

- For General Cleaning purpose, a glass cleaner like Windex can be used. Spray on and wipe off with a clean, soft cloth.
- Alternatively, Vinegar or a few drops of methylated spirits on a damp nonabrasive cloth wipe over mirror, buff with a clean, soft cloth for a streak free finish.
- Do not under any circumstances use any form of abrasive cleaner as this may cause damage to the glass for example Jif.
- Do not clean with steel wool, razorblades etc.
- Do not allow any metal or hard parts of other cleaning equipment to come in contact with the glass.

Shower Screens & Robe Doors - Powder Coat & Aluminium Frame

- Aluminium frames should be wiped with a clean, non-abrasive damp cloth.
- Wardrobe tracks should be kept free of dirt and dust with regular brushing or vacuum cleaning.
- Regularly check sliding doors where necessary to prevent scapping damage to the sill.
- Occasional use of a mild detergent and warm water solution may be necessary to shift stubborn dirt and stains.

Shower Screen fittings

- It is recommended that owners regularly inspect the following aspects of the operation of their frameless shower screens.
- Check hinges and clamp fittings at least once every six months to ensure screws have not become loose.
- To clean hardware such as hinges, and joint connectors use a mild detergent and warm water solution to wipe clean. Then rinse with clean warm water.
- Under no circumstances use solvent or harsh detergents, bleach, scour's, or any other abrasive cleaner.
- Check the operation of the hinges to ensure that they hinge freely and operate smoothly.
